

Minutes – Meeting of 25 October, 2012

Call to order: 7:30

Present: Gorman, Harris and Hickman

Guest: Greg Legendre

Mid-City Youth Volleyball (MCYV) has applied for 501(c)(3) status with the IRS. The IRS has received our application and says a determination will be made within approximately 90 days of October 15 if the application does not require significant additional development. MCYV is awaiting this determination in order to open a checking account with Capital One Bank. In the meantime MCYV will be dependent upon our parent organization, Mid-City Volleyball Group (MCVG), for financial support. The MCYV board will request this support at the next MCVG meeting (scheduled for 7 November, 2012). MCYV will ask for re-imbusement for equipment and supplies purchased for the youth clinics (scheduled to start Saturday, November 3, 2012). MCYV will also request that MCVG reimburse any adult who passes the Beach Increased Mastery and Professional Application of Coaching Theory (Beach IMPACT) course offered by USA Volleyball subject to the said adult assisting in at least one of the Saturday youth clinics. The fee for Beach IMPACT certification is \$50 (\$25 with previous indoor IMPACT certification). Adults must become members of USA Volleyball before obtaining Beach IMPACT certification, and the USAV membership fee will be the sole responsibility of the adult.

Greg Legendre was present to assist the MCYV board in editing the MCYV web page(s). Mr. Legendre reformatted the existing MCVG website [www.midcityvolleyball.org] with the more user-friendly WordPress software, and then he created a new MCYV website [www.midcityyouthvolleyball.org] based on the MCVG website. Mr. Legendre showed the MCYV board how to edit or add content to existing pages, create new pages, upload photos and videos and went over the process required to collect fees online using PayPal. Mr. Legendre also noted that he is charging MCYV a very reduced rate of \$15/hour.
